We have also received wonderful support from parents and parishioners. Thank you to everyone for their commitment to the school and to our children.

The school's governors have been working with the Departments of Education and Infrastructure, as well as local politicians to resolve the issues which are preventing us from proceeding with a new school build. The issue of a footpath connecting the new school building to both villages has not yet been resolved. The Department of Education has also commissioned site searches in the locality. The governors will keep you informed of developments in this area.

I hope the children are excited about starting school, putting on their new uniform and looking forward to a successful and happy year. There are many exciting curricular and extra-curricular developments which will be taking place during the year and I have outlined some of them overleaf in this newsletter.

Working with our parents will be a key aim for the new school and this month I have started a consultation exercise

with parents about the feasibility of setting up a Morning Club which would operate from 8 a.m. daily. There is also a meeting, this month, to establish a Parent Teacher Association and I look forward to meeting with you and working together, in partnership.

The school's website will be launched this month and I hope you find it helpful in keeping up to date with everything that is happening in the school, including key dates and events. The website will make the links between home and school stronger.
