SAFEGUARDING

The NSPCC's *Speak out. Stay safe.* programme is visiting Mary Queen of Peace PS on **Tuesday 8** and **Wednesday 9 January 2019**. They will be presenting an assembly to each of the Key Stages and a workshop for Primary 6 and 7 pupils, which will teach the children how to keep themselves safe from harm and how to get help if they have any worries.

In addition, the NSPCC has organised a Parent Workshop with O2 to help keep children safe when they are on-line. This will take place on **Tuesday 8 January 2019 @ 2 p.m.** in the **Parish Hall**. The content covered in the workshop is aimed at adults. Parents with children are advised to arrange childcare if possible. The hour-long workshop will help parents, carers and other adults understand their child's online world; build confidence to have those important conversations that can help keep children safe online; and help you know where to go for assistance and advice.



SCHOOL DEVELOPMENT PLAN

Mathematics

The Parent Teacher Association has secured a £3,000 grant from The Community Foundation for Northern Ireland. The grant will purchase IZAK9 Maths Cubes.

IZAK9 is a unique and innovative resource in the teaching and learning of mathematics. It is an immersive, multi-media rich, active learning device designed to challenge pupils' problem solving and thinking skills.



SCHOOL CLUBS

We have camogie (Mrs McAlister), hurling (Mr McKenna) and cross-country (Mr Conlon) clubs ahead of big competitions this month. There are also three exciting new clubs: Rugby (Y4/5 Council), Trailblazer Shared Education Club (Y6/7, Mrs McConway) with Clough PS and a Growing Club (Y5). Growing Club

Antrim and Newtownabbey Borough Council have generously accepted Mary Queen of Peace's application to create a **Growing Club** within our school. Primary 5 pupils will work alongside volunteers from the council to create raised beds, a wildflower garden and wild bird area. The club will begin towards the end of January and will last for 6 weeks. This is a very exciting opportunity as we make small steps towards achieving our Green Flag.



SHARED EDUCATION

Trailblazer After School Club

A number of Primary 6/7 pupils will participate in an 'Wheelworks' project funded by T: BUC Together: Building United Communities. Our pupils will join with pupils from Clough PS to create an app which will highlight the facilities and tourist opportunities in the Glenravel/Clough area. Beginning on **Saturday 19 January 2019**, the children will have a Meet and Greet Day before they begin their joint venture. The children will then meet every Tuesday, alternating between the schools, until the end of March. This is an excellent opportunity for Shared Education as well as a platform to enhance an important area of our School Development Plan: ICT Film & Animation



Shared Education with Camphill PS

Following on from a very successful 'Get to know you day' at the Sports Hut in November, Camphill PS and MQP Year 4 classes look forward to beginning their Shared Education project this term. Dates of when and where the children will meet are posted on the website calendar. The first session will take place in Mary Queen of Peace PS on **Friday 11 January 2019**. We look forward to welcoming the children and staff from Camphill PS to Glenravel.

We have chosen 'Friendship' as our theme. Over the next ten weeks the children will come together to share their skills in ICT, music, literacy and art to explore the idea of Friendship. Our Y4 children are incredibly excited to meet up again with the children from Camphill PS and if Day 1 is anything to go by we think this Shared Education project will be a great success for all involved. The project will end with a Celebration Assembly which we will invite family and friends to. More details to follow.
